## COVID-19 - Skate Park, Kick About, Children's Playground and Outdoor Gym Risk Assessment

COVID-19 is a new illness that can affect your lungs and airways and is caused by a virus called Coronavirus. The symptoms can be mild, moderate, severe, or fatal.

The decision to reopen the skate park, kick about area, outside gym and partly reopen the children's playground is based on the local situation in Markfield. It considers the specific risks from COVID-19 to the Public.
