Fees now include 10% (rounded to the nearest £1.00) Cemetery Improvement Levy. All fees are payable in advance.

1. INTERMENT FEES

(i)	The body of a person whose age does not exceed 18 years in a grave	£0.00
(ii)	The body of a person whose age exceeded 18 years in a grave	£605.00
(iii)	Of a cremation casket in a grave or casket plot	£237.00
(iv)	Recorded scattered cremated remains on grave or Gardens	£121.00

2. EXCLUSIVE RIGHT OF BURIAL

(i)	For an exclusive right of interment for 100 years in a casket plot 5 x 3	£373.00
(ii)	For an exclusive right of burial for 100 years in an earthen grave 8 x 4	£715.00

3. MONUMENTS AND MONUMENTAL INSCRIPTIONS

GRAVES and CREMATED REMAINS PLOT - Kerbstones are not permitted.

A stone headstone	£204.00
Additional inscriptions	£109.00
A Tablet vase/small headstone	£115.00

The Council must approve all memorials before any work is undertaken. The Council reserves the right to remove any unauthorised memorial. Planting on graves is not permitted. Graves will be turfed over by the Council at the appropriate time.

4. ADDITIONAL CHARGES

Double fees. All the above fees will be DOUBLED for persons who were not inhabitants of the Parish of Markfield at the time of their death but who had a very strong connection with Markfield. This surcharge will be relaxed for long term residents who have lived within the parish for at least 25 years, but who lived outside the parish for health care reasons normally for no longer than five years prior to their death.

Treble fees. All the above fees will be TREBLED for persons who were not inhabitants of the Parish of Markfield at the time of death and who did not have a very strong connection with Markfield.

These rules do not apply when an exclusive right of burial has been acquired by a person who at the time of the acquisition was an inhabitant of the parish.
